Research Section

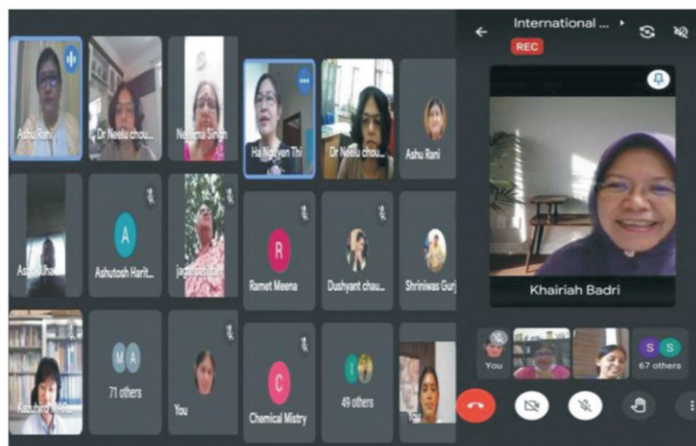

ORGANISED AT THE CAMPUS:**

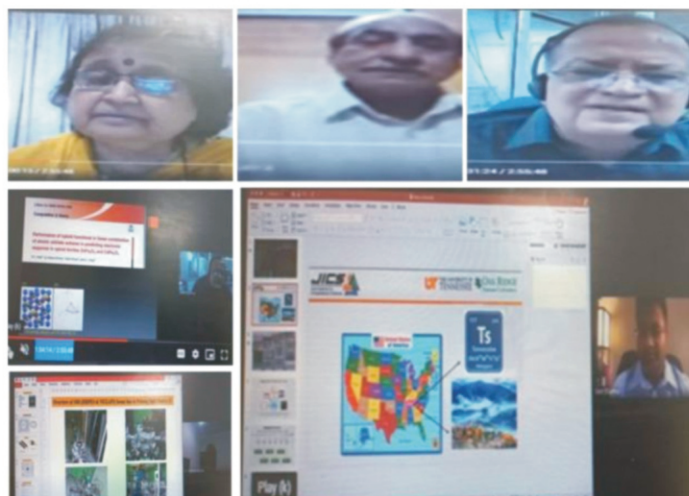

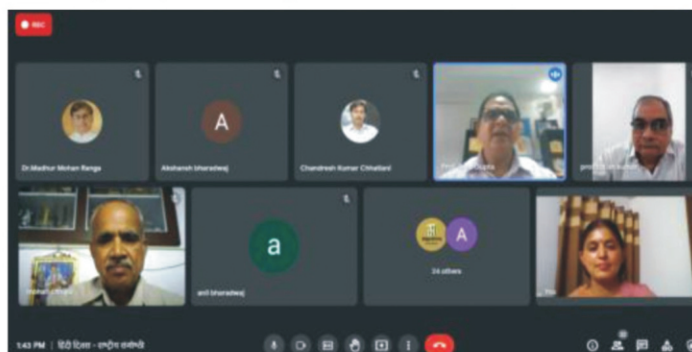
- One Day Orientation Camp was organised by Unit-I and II of National Service Scheme, University of Kota on 23rd December 2021 for the new NSS

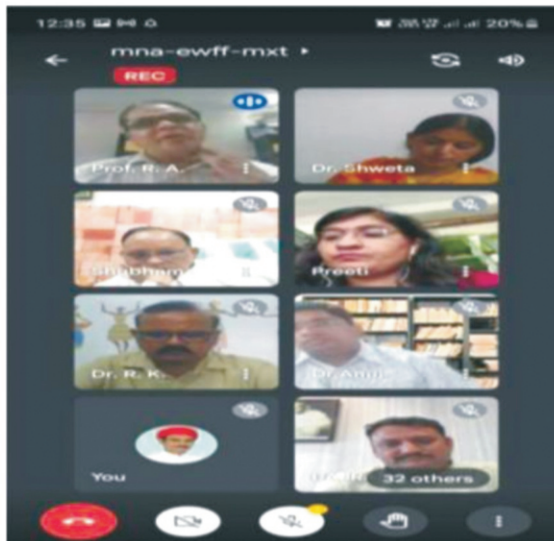
